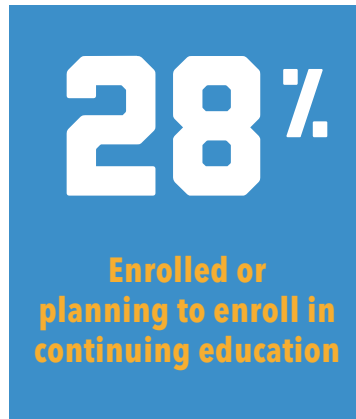

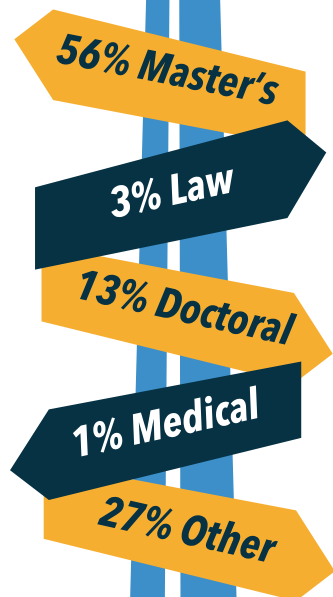

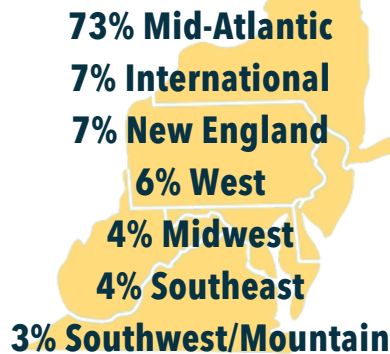

FULL TIME EMPLOYMENT

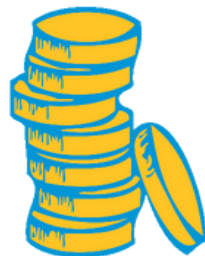
