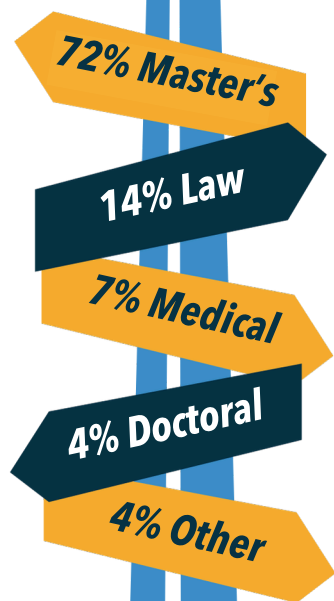

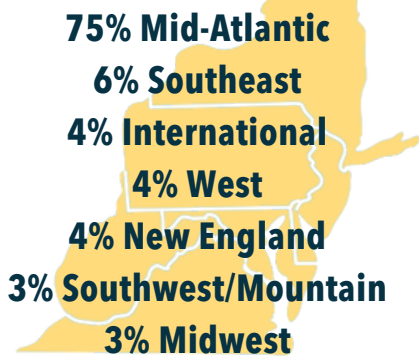

FULL TIME EMPLOYMENT

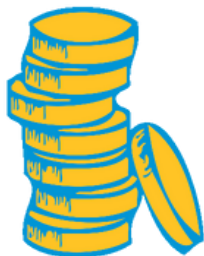
